

or much of the past year, the Biden administration has struggled to find ways to ease the price of oil amid the shock of Russia's war in Ukraine. So when OPEC+ decided to cut oil production by two million barrels per day in early October, Washington's reaction was unsparing. "It's clear," asserted White House Press Secretary Karine Jean-Pierre, "that OPEC+ is aligning with Russia." The blunt criticism was all the more striking given that it was aimed at Saudi Arabia, an important U.S. partner in the Middle East. The administration's black-and-white view of Saudi motives is in line with its broader perspective on partners. Since coming to office, the Biden administration has frequently taken a binary view of the international order. Partly as a result, it has tended to treat decisions by its partners as a litmus test of loyalty to the United States. But this is a vision that many U.S. partners do not share...


