**A**nother day, another Saudi headline—but one far different from the usual riff about the murder of journalist Jamal Khashoggi, the war in Yemen, or the kingdom's imprisoned women activists: The state-owned oil company Saudi Aramco made more profit last year than any other company in the world. According to the *Wall Street Journal*, its net income was \$111 billion. Before taxes and other expenses it made \$212 billion. Reaching for comparisons, the *Journal* said the revenue figure was similar to the combined military budgets of the 28 members of the European Union...
