# RAPID RISE

TODAY Through trade, investment, and travel, Turkey and the KRG now enjoy a street relationship, which favors Turkey as the larger and more advanced economic power.




By comparison, excluding oil and gas, Iraqi exports to Turkey—and by extension, KRG exports—are negligible, ranging from \$87 million to \$153 million between 2007 and 2014.


