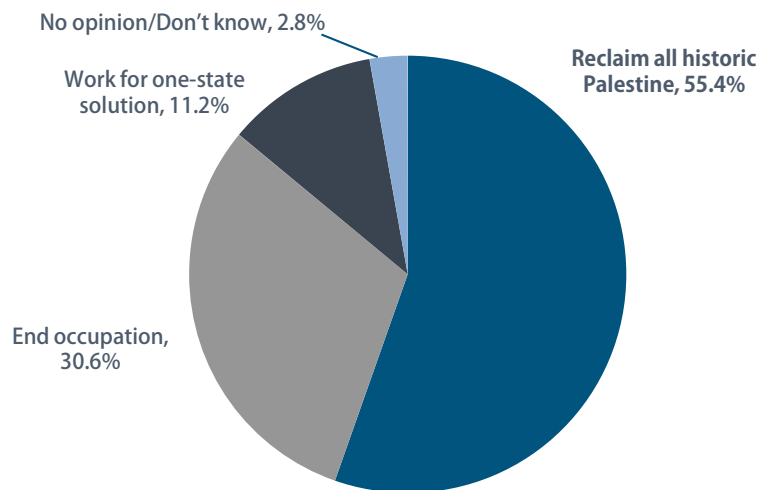


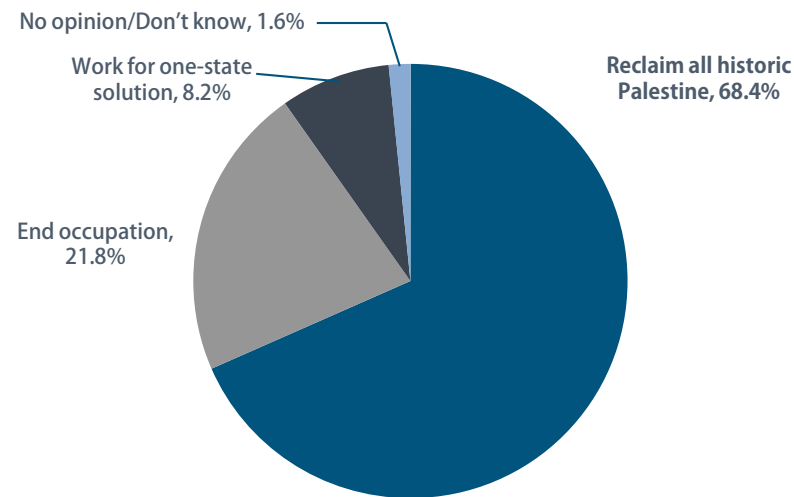

Gaza



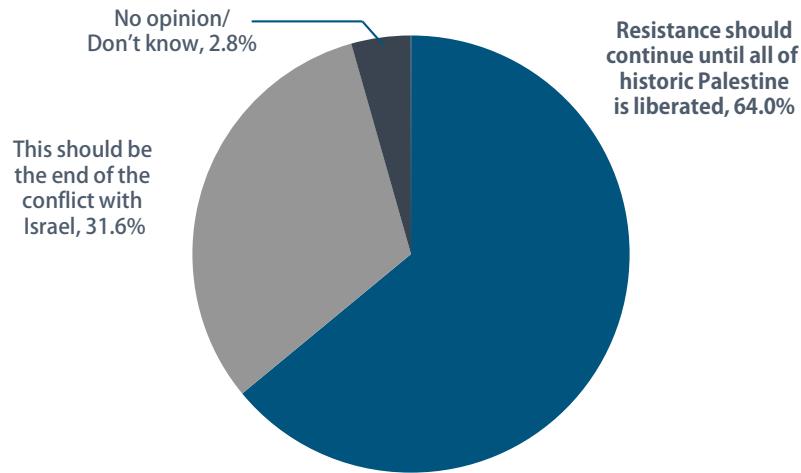

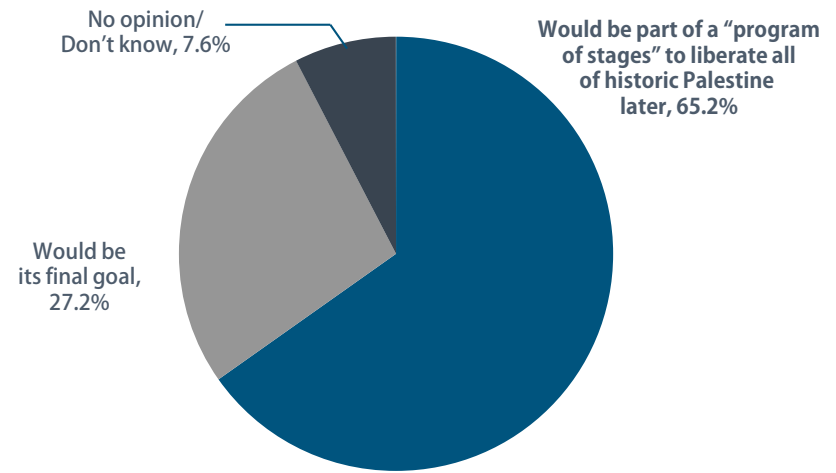

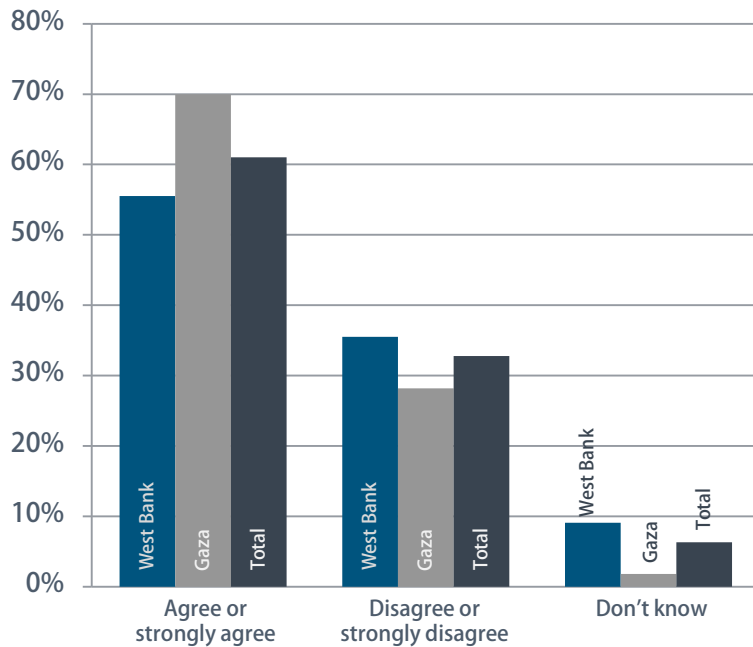

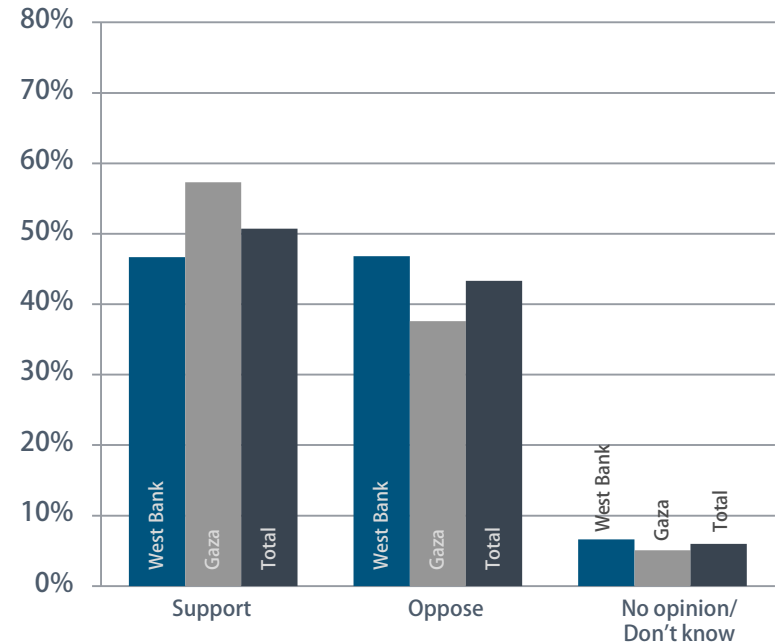

Hamas should accept Abbas’s position on the unity government renouncing violence:



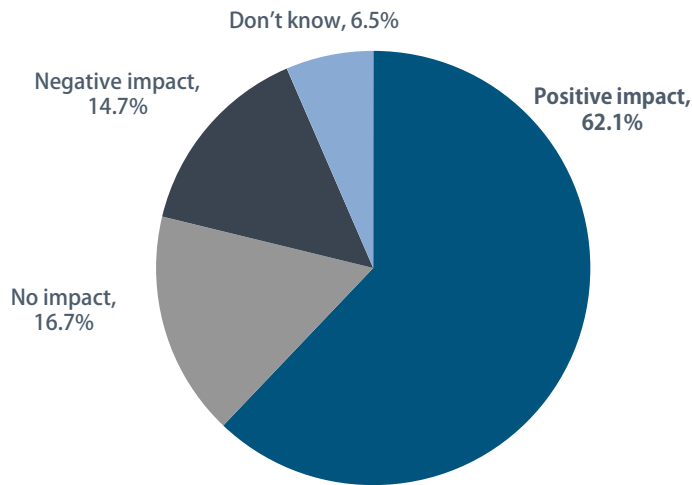

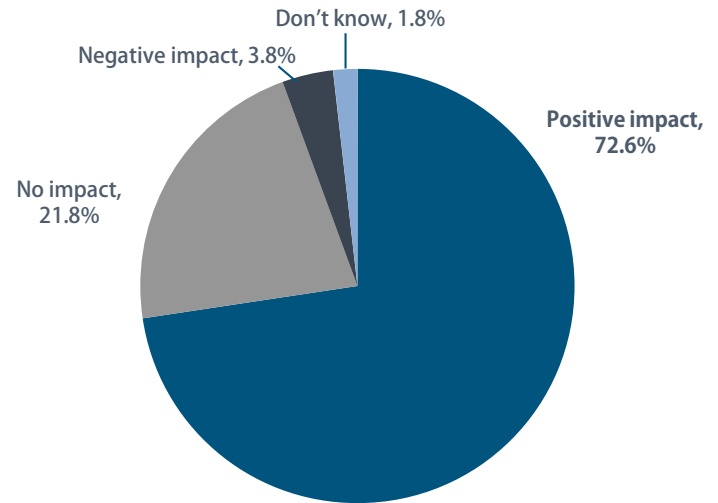
Palestinian Public Wants “Popular Resistance,” Not Violence

West Bank



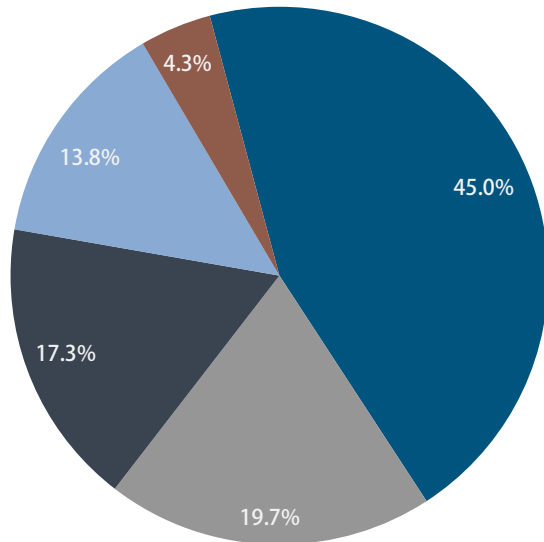

What would you say is the one thing Israel could do to convince Palestinians that it really wants peace and a two-state solution? (West Bank and Gaza)



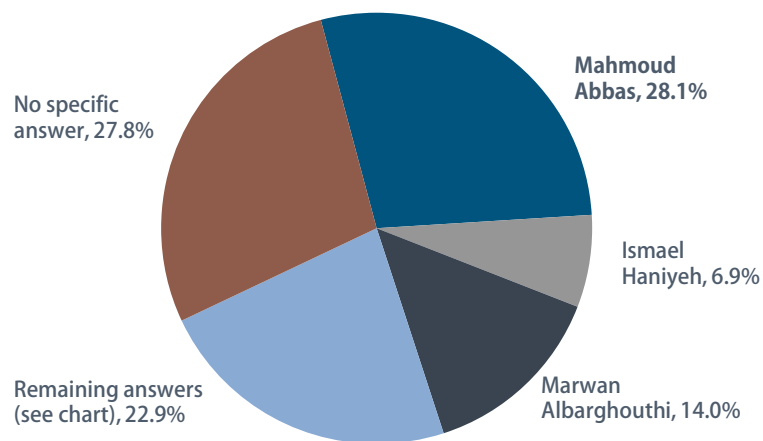
- Israel should release more Palestinian prisoners, 45.0%

- No opinion/Don't know, 4.3%

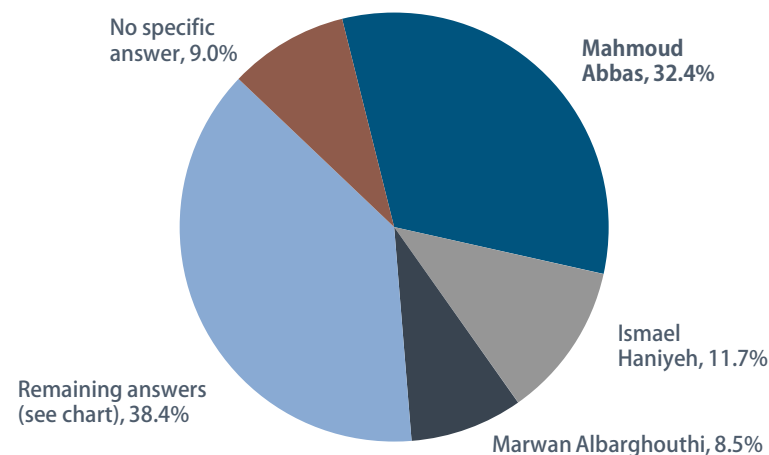
Hamas is Not Gaining Political Ground

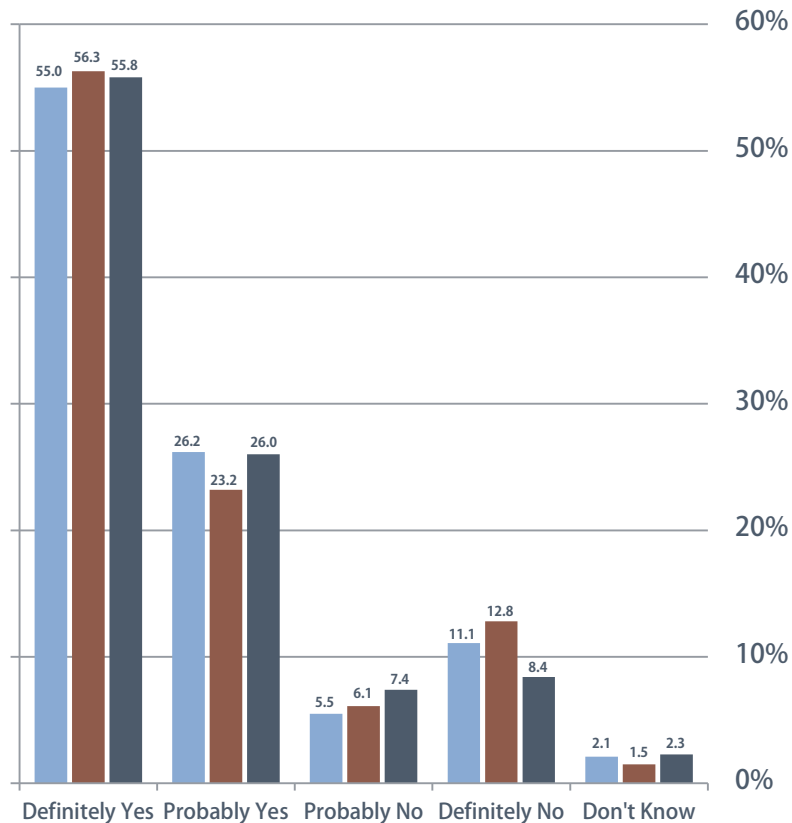

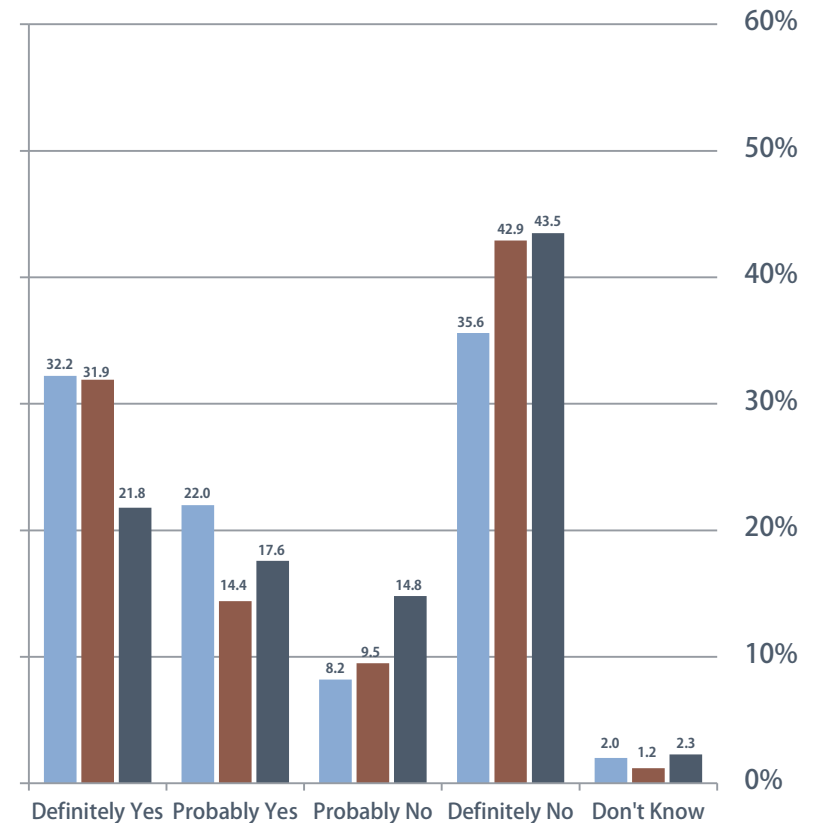

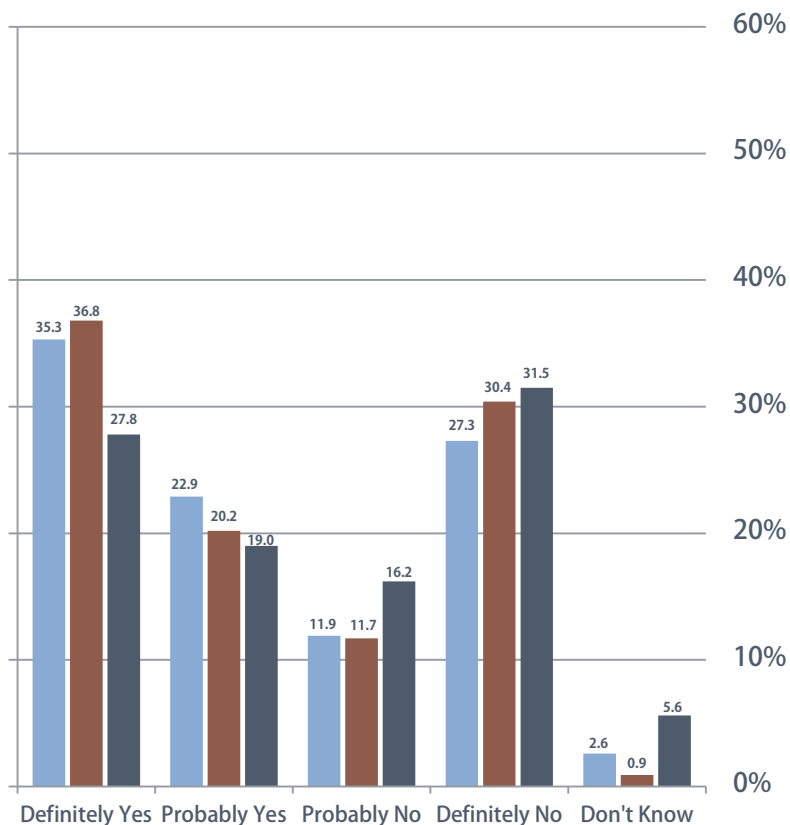

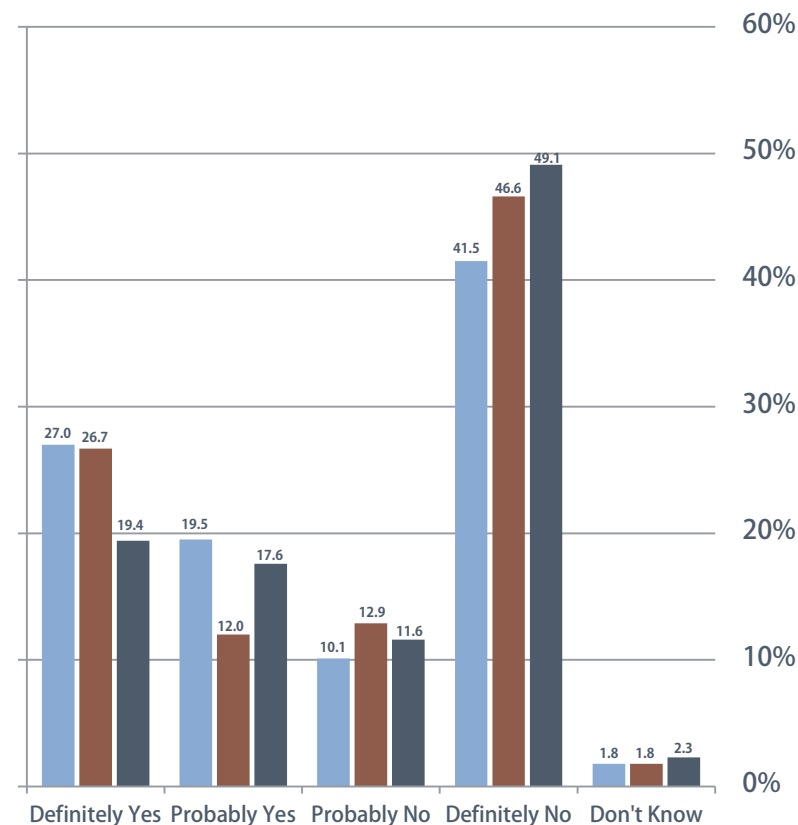
Would you like to see Israeli companies offer more jobs inside the West Bank/Gaza?
